- Continue to monitor student growth and meet grade level expectations



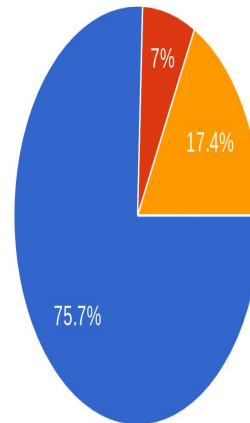

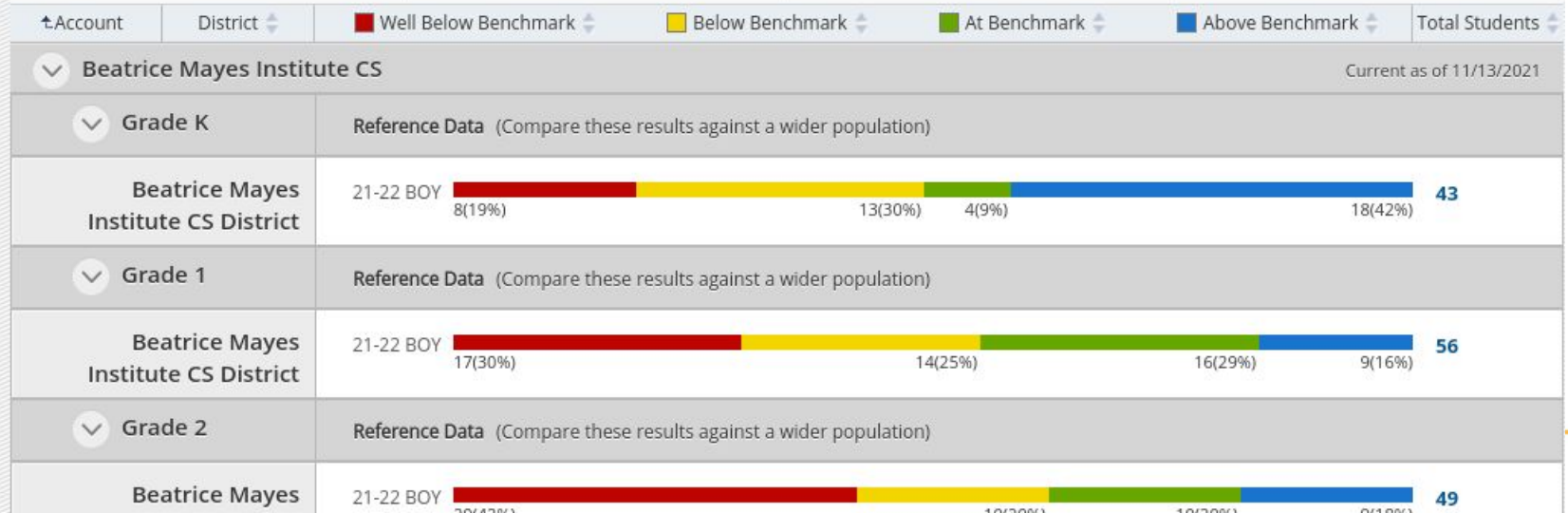
